MOTHER'S DAY CRAFTS



What you'll need:

- Styrofoam cup
- Small chunk of floral foam
- Colorful buttons
- White craft glue
- Yellow acrylic paint
- Paintbrush
- Scissors

How to make it:

- 1. Paint cup yellow, inside and out and let dry completely.
- 2. Glue buttons around the rim of the cup and let dry.

Glue small chunks of floral foam inside the cup to insert stick flowers in to.

Tips:

- Buy large bags of colorful buttons at your local craft store.
- Styrofoam cups and bowls are inexpensive and are great for craft projects.
- If using this project to hold paper flowers, shred or cut up some green construction or tissue paper to cover the flower foam.



What you'll need:

- Glass bottle
- Rainbow colored string
- White craft glue
- Strip of green felt, measured to go around top of bottle
- Toothpick
- Scissors

How to make it:

Be sure glass bottle is clean and dry. Apply white craft glue all around the bottom part of the bottle, one inch high.

Start wrapping string around the bottom of the bottle. Continue wrapping, keeping the string close together, gently pushing down with a toothpick if needed. Add more glue and continue wrapping string until you reach the top of the bottle.

Cut a piece of felt wide enough to cover the lip of the bottle and long enough to wrap around it once. Glue in place. Allow everything to dry completely.

Tips:

- 1. This project can be done all in one sitting or in several steps. If your child needs a break, simply place the bottle somewhere and pick it up again later.
- 2. Look for rainbow colored string at your local craft store. String is sold in large spools.
- 3. Save glass bottle from condiments, sauces, or juice to use for projects such as this.
