Dear friends,

This Sunday will be the third of six in a sermon series called "Lessons from Jacob". Jacob is no super saint or unreachable model of spirituality. He is flawed, as we all are. In spite of his flaws and stubborn

willfulness, God works in and through him. There are important lessons we can learn.

There is an epic struggle between the Jacob and Esau that begins before birth. They were even fighting in the womb. What does their lifelong battle center around? It is the consuming desire to be validated. It is about the blessing of their earthly father. What Jacob does not realize is that he does not have to step on everyone in his path in order to be blessed.

When Jacob tricks his father into giving the blessing to him that was intended to go to Esau, Esau cries from the bottom of his soul. In Gen. 27:36, one of the most heart-breaking verses in the Bible, Esau cries to Isaac, "Haven't you reserved any blessing for me?" His father has no blessing to give.

Esau is like many people who continue to ask for a blessing from people who do not have one to give. Often, the people they are asking did not get a blessing from their own parents or guardians. People can spend a lifetime looking for the blessing.

There is a higher blessing from God. God is generous; offering it to all. John 3:16 says it eloquently. "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life."

Have you received that blessing? Have you grasped the depth of that blessing? Read and absorb that verse. Realize how much God is blessing and valuing you! Then go pass that blessing of God's great love to someone else in His name!
