### Dear church family and friends,

The eyes of the world were on Charlottesville, VA this past weekend. A march took place that included white supremacy groups such as the KKK, neo-Nazis, etc. They were protesting the removal of a statue of Robert E. Lee. Counter-protesters gathered to oppose them. Tragically, violence broke out. People were injured. Lives were lost.

Finger-pointing and post-event analyzing began immediately. What is the answer? Solutions have been suggested: tighter regulation of marches, greater authority for law enforcement, or leaving certain Civil War statues in place.

These solutions do not go deep enough. We have tried political solutions, social solutions, law enforcement solutions, etc. Human solutions will not fix these problems. We cannot "save" ourselves. We need saving. The Bible tells us that sin is part of the human DNA. The Apostle Paul says in Rom. 3:23 – "All have sinned and fall short of the glory of God". Sin is simply putting what I want ahead of everyone else.

Sin leads to selfishness, hatred, and many kinds of destructiveness. The forces of sin and hate conspired to execute Jesus. When He died on the cross, it seemed those forces had won. But, on the third day, we know that Jesus rose from the dead! Sin and hate did not have the last word. Love had the last word. That is still true today.

The cross of Jesus is a living testimony that God's love is stronger than hate, no matter how things appear! Jesus summarizes the message of the Bible in Matthew 22:37-39 - "Love God...neighbor [and]... self" (Matthew 22:37-39). The theme? God's love. His love is the answer, the only answer! As we are captured by His love, and live it out, little by little, we, and our world are changed.


