

But on <u>Aug. 16</u>, Bible Study will resume onsite, as well as online each Wednesday evening at 7pm.



Biblical taste is a term that refers to the experience of knowing God & His goodness through personal & intimate contact. It is not a mere intellectual knowledge, but a spiritual & emotional one that involves the senses & the heart. The Bible uses the word "taste" to describe this kind of experience in several passages, such as:

<u>Psalm 34:8:</u> "O taste and see that the LORD is good: blessed is the man that trusteth in him." This verse invites us to try God's goodness for ourselves, & to enjoy His blessings & protection. It implies that God is not only a concept, but a reality that can be perceived and felt.

Hebrews 6:4-5: "For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift, and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, And have tasted the good word of God, and the powers of the world to come," This passage warns us about the danger of falling away from God after having experienced His grace & power. It suggests that God's gift, word, & Spirit are not only doctrines, but experiences that can transform our lives.

Hebrews 2:9: "But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels for the suffering of death, crowned with glory and honour; that He by the grace of God should taste death for every man." This verse reveals the extent of Jesus' love and sacrifice for us. He did not only die physically, but also spiritually, experiencing the separation from God that sin causes. He tasted death for us, so that we may taste life in Him.

Biblical taste is a way of knowing God that goes beyond mere information or speculation. It is a way of relating to God that involves our whole being, our senses, our emotions, our will, & our faith. It is a way of tasting & seeing that God is good, & that He has given us His Son to taste death for us, so that we may have eternal life in Him.
