Dear Church Family and Friends.

How do you get stronger in any area of life? Through resistance. Using it to work for you instead of against you. This means exercise. Physical, mental, or spiritual. It makes you stronger.

On the other hand, what happens if you do not exercise or if there is no resistance? You get weaker. Every time.

For example, astronauts who spend a lot of time in space have to cope with less gravity. Less gravity means less resistance. Muscles don't work as hard. They weaken. Many astronauts suffer from the effects of low gravity long after they get back to earth.

Following Jesus can result in you getting resistance from the world. If you live out Jesus' teachings, it causes you to stand out. It could make others uncomfortable. Some may ignore you. Others may question you or even be hostile to you.

You may find this resistance hurtful or offensive. Instead, try to think of it as resistance that can strengthen you. Allow it to launch you to new heights.

The Apostle Paul was an expert on this subject. He said, "We are hard pressed on every side, but not crushed; perplexed, but not in despair, persecuted, but not abandoned; struck down, but not destroyed." (II Cor. 4:8-9)
