Dear Church Family and Friends,

The coronavirus. It's been a news headline for weeks. Starting in China, it has crossed its borders to infect 73,250 people around the world. Travel

restrictions are in place to contain it.

Any flu or flu-like virus is contagious. You catch it from contact with the carrier. Anxiety (fear and anger) are contagious, **too.** They spread from contact with the carriers. Thinking shuts down. Our faith is overwhelmed. Relationships suffer.

So...what does this have to do with personality types? The last of the nine types is the Peacemaker. Jesus says, "Blessed are the peacemakers" (Matt. 5:9). Now for the good news... Calmness and inner peace are contagious, too.

Which of the two are you spreading...anxiety or peace?

Peacemakers at their best relate to all nine personality types. They can be diplomatic and non-threatening. This helps calm people so they can talk to each other.

The peacemaker at his or her worst can be passive and avoid conflict.

Even if you are not the Peacemaker personality type, you can bring "the peace of God, which transcends all understanding" (Phil. 4:7) into the room.

Be contagious this week...with God's love and peace! It will make a difference!

He uses his life experience to aid others in their pursuit of living a drug-free lifestyle as productive members of society. Jason works closely with the faith-based community to help break the stigma of addiction or felony background in the church. After spending 5 years in incarceration he has a heart for people who are battling the bondage of addiction.

Jason's role at Ballad Health is to engage those who are affiliated with the recovery community, existing organic grass root coalitions and the faith-based community to overcome the opioid epidemic that now ravages Southwest Virginia and Northeast Tennessee.


SUNDAY SCHOOL & WORSHIP
