Dear church family and friends,

What a blessing for our church to be able to fellowship together to see the new movie, "Risen"! Leigh, for organizing the event.

The movie unfolds through the eyes of Clavius, a Roman centurion and unbeliever. Clavius is weary and cynical. He has seen so much death that he just wishes for one day without death.

When Jesus' tomb is found empty, Pilate assigns Clavius to find the body. Some lewish leaders feared the disciples stole the body so they could claim Jesus rose from the dead. This is a threat to those leaders and the Roman authorities.

Since Clavius saw Jesus die, he began his detective work to simply find a body. He interviews guards from the tomb. He examines the tomb and grave clothes. He tracks rumors. He gets closer to the source until He talks to the actual disciples and Jesus' Himself!

The movie also gives us a window into the world of Jesus' day. The people of Palestine have little power. Roman soldiers can burst into your home for any reason. Roman tax collectors can rob you blind. Politically, economically, and socially—the disciples are powerless. Yet, through the power of God, they turn the world upside down!

We are all Clavius. We are weary. We have seen too much suffering and death. We are also like the disciples. We feel powerless in the face of many larger forces around us.

Because Jesus is risen, we can find a peace that passes all understanding! Because Jesus lives, His power through us can turn the world upside down for His sake!


# MARK YOUR CALENDAR

# WEDNESDAY NIGHT MEAL AND BIBLE STUDY

If the Wise area is experiencing inclement weather, i.e. snow, ice, on a Wednesday, a decision will be made by the Pastor as to whether our meal and Bible study will be held as usual or cancelled.

We will **NOT** automatically cancel our activities because Wise County or Norton City schools are closed.

The decision to cancel our activities will be made no later than 2:00 pm and will be communicated through email, website, Facebook, and phone calls.

Your safety is most important. Please don't attempt to get out if the weather/conditions are dangerous.

# SUNDAY SCHOOL AND WORSHIP

We will have Sunday School and Worship even during inclement weather. The exception to this will be if our building is without power.

Our Pastor and Building Stewards will make that decision, if necessary.

In the event that our services are cancelled, communication will be sent via email, website, Facebook and phone calls.

Your safety is most important. Please don't attempt to get out if the weather/conditions are dangerous.
