
### Season 2, Episodes 3 & 4



Many of you may not have recognized the song I played for the offertory yesterday, "People Get Ready." It was written in 1965 by Curtis Mayfield after he had attended the March on Washington the year before. The train that is coming in the song speaks to a chance for redemption -- the long-sought chance to rise above racism, to stand apart from despair and any desire for retaliation. "People Get Ready" became a song that represented the Civil Rights movement in the 1960s. Because of its importance and meaning, I felt that it would be a great song to play for the last Sunday of Black History Month. I also intertwined Bob Marley's "One Love" with it, which speaks to a universal love and respect for <u>all</u> people.

So people get ready There's a train a comin' You don't need no baggage You just get on board All you need is faith To hear the diesels hummin' Don't need no ticket You just thank the Lord


