Dear church family and friends,

How do we discern God's will? His will is not a mysterious plan to decipher. It means keeping a close relationship with Him.

Compare God's will to riding a canoe down a river. The goal is to **ride with the current** to a destination. We must **navigate past obstacles**, such as rocks, tree limbs, and white water. There is **room to navigate** from side to side.

Traveling with the flow of God's will is more efficient than going upstream. This does not mean there are no obstacles. Also, there is room for our free will to operate within this "river".

Obstacles sometimes confuse us about God's will. Joshua knew that God's will was to lead the Hebrews into the Promised Land, but he encountered obstacles. How could an untrained, unequipped, people conquer a powerful, walled city?

Joshua absorbed the words of Joshua 1:8 – "Do not let the Book of the Law depart from your mouth; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful."

Absorbing God's Word helps us to know and do God's will. Meditation means to make the Scripture a part of us. It means to keep Scriptures we read in our hearts, minds, and mouths.


