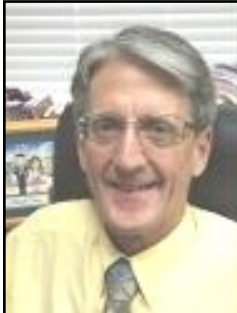

God bless you all!! Ben

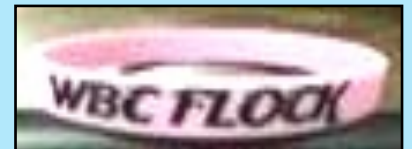

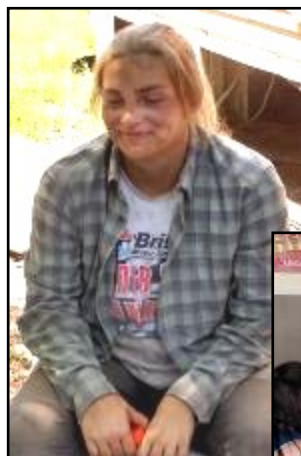

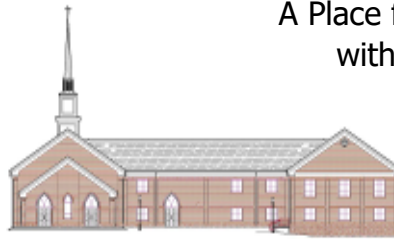
