Dear Church Family and Friends,

Listening affects the quality of every relationship. A good example of "listening" happened during the deadliest tsunami (tidal wave) ever.

On December 26, 2004 a huge earthquake occurred deep in the Indian Ocean. The shock waves produced 100-foot high waves. 227,898 lives were lost. But, one group of people survived without a single death.

How? Because they had learned to "listen". The Moken people are an ethnic group that spend their whole lives on the water. They know the ocean better than anyone.

On the day of the earthquake, photographers have pictures of Moken people crying. They "listened" as the ocean waters pulled back from the shores rapidly. They "listened" as the dolphins swam out to sea. They "listened" as the birds and cicadas fell silent. They "listened" as the elephants moved to higher ground.

Because they "listened", Mokens near the shore got off their boats and moved to higher ground. Mokens who were too far out to sea, went out further to avoid tidal waves as they crested.

As a result, not a single Moken perished. Listening...can save a relationship, a life and an eternity. Jesus says over and over, "He who has ears to hear, let him hear" (Mark 4:9).






