Blueberry Crumble

*One of the desserts served at our Feast of Weeks meal on May 24.

- 4 cups blueberries, fresh or frozen
- 2 Tablespoons brown sugar
- 2 Tablespoons maple syrup
- I Tablespoon lemon juice
- 2 Tablespoons corn starch

Preheat oven to 375F. Coat a 9" pie dish with cooking spray. Combine blueberries, brown sugar, maple syrup, & lemon juice in a large bowl & toss well. Add the corn starch & toss again, so blueberries are coated. Set aside.

TOPPING: 1/2 cup almond meal or almond flour

1/2 cup all-purpose flour

1/2 cup old fashioned oats

2 Tablespoons brown sugar

I teaspoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon cinnamon

1/3 cup coconut oil, softened

In a medium bowl, combine all ingredients, except the coconut oil, & mix well. Add the coconut oil, working it in with your hands until it is well incorporated.

Transfer the blueberry mixture to the pie dish, sprinkle the topping on top, & place the pie dish on a baking sheet. Place on the lower rack of the oven & bake for 40 minutes.


STEWARDSHIP: Managing God-Given Resources for God's Work
