Dear Church Family and Friends.

Contradictions in the Bible. Critics point them out to discredit the Bible. Contradictions cause doubt or

embarrassment for followers of Jesus.

There is a different way to approach "contradictions". Jesus says in Matthew 22:37-40 that the law is summed up by loving God with all your heart and loving your neighbor as self. Galatians 5:14 says the entire law is fulfilled if the Galatians would "love your neighbor as yourself."

Looks like a contradiction, right? Close examination says otherwise. If you simply read the context (surrounding verses), you will find Jesus and Paul are speaking to two different situations.

The Pharisees were making following God difficult and complicated. In response, Jesus boiled God's requirements down to two commandments. Paul wrote to a group of believers who were treating each other badly. That led him to focus on loving one's neighbor.

Use each "contradiction" to discover God's deeper truth.

- 2 small cauliflower heads
- I cup fresh parsley, chopped
- 2 Tablespoons garlic powder
- I teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 2 eggs, beaten
- I cup all-purpose flour
- I cup feta cheese, crumbled
- 1/2 cup parmesan cheese
- olive oil for pan frying

Wash cauliflower heads & cut into small chunks. Transfer them into a food processor & pulse until finely chopped.

In a large bowl, combine the rest of the ingredients (except parmesan cheese). Add chopped cauliflower, mix well, & let mixture sit in refrigerator for 20 minutes.

Using your hands, form 16-18 patties. Carefully sprinkle each side with parmesan cheese.

Heat about 1/2" of oil in a large skillet. Gently place patties in hot oil. Cook over medium heat for 3-4 minutes per side until golden brown.

Serve with plain Greek yogurt & fresh tomatoes.


STEWARDSHIP: Managing God-Given Resources for God's Work


