Chocolate Peanut Butter & Pretzel Tart

*One of the desserts served at our Feast of Weeks meal on May 24.

CRUST: 3 1/2 cups salted mini pretzels (twisted)

- 3 Tablespoons coconut oil, melted
- 3 Tablespoons peanut butter
- 2 teaspoons maple syrup

Preheat oven to 350. Place 3 cups of pretzels in a food processor or blender & pulse until ground. Add melted coconut oil, peanut butter & maple syrup; pulse until well combined. Transfer pretzel mixture into a non-stick 11" x 5" tart pan. Gently press it evenly into the pan. Bake for 8-10 min. Let cool slightly & place in refrigerator until it cools completely.

CHOCOLATE GANACHE:

- I cup mini chocolate chips
- I cup full-fat canned coconut milk
- I/2 cup peanut butter

Place chocolate chips in a large glass or metal heatproof bowl. Heat the coconut milk in a saucepan over medium heat, until bubbles start to form on the sides; pour over

the chocolate chips & let sit 2-3 minutes undisturbed.

Gently whisk until all the chocolate has melted & it is smooth. Whisk in peanut butter until well blended. Pour chocolate mixture over the cooled crust. Decorate with pretzels. Refrigerate for at least 3 hours.


STEWARDSHIP: Managing God-Given Resources for God's Work
