

I was struggling with what to write about for this week's newsletter and Mike knocked on my door and was showing me a book that Stan had lent him about "doubts". We discussed it for a while and really came to no real conclusion. Religious scholars have argued, studied, and written about doubts throughout the centuries. Scientists have done the same thing.

Our Bible says that the earth was created in 7 days and I do believe that, but do I really think it was done in 7 of <u>our</u> days? That's really doubtful, but is probably correct in God's timing of 7 days. I'm sure God does not go by our calendar; therefore, he doesn't go by our clock with 60 seconds in every hour and 24 hours in every day.
