I would attempt to figure out a way to take the punishment for them, but not to be ridiculed, beaten, paraded around, then be slowly & painfully executed.

But not MY Jesus! He did that FOR ME & FOR YOU! He took all that they could throw at Him & made it a celebration of His triumph over Satan, death, destruction & turned it into an event that we remember & celebrate each year with Easter.
