Cheese Blintzes Recipe

WRAPS:

S: I I/4 cup whole milk

I cup all-purpose flour

1/2 tsp salt

l egg

2/3 cup water

I/2 TBSP oil

Combine together beating vigorously. Let rest 1-2 hrs. Heat 8" non-stick skillet, grease slightly and pour 1/4 -1/3 cup of mixture into bottom and roll around, covering entire bottom. Let sit for approx. I minute or until edges begin to brown. Carefully flip and cook for 10 seconds, remove from pan. Set aside.


### STEWARDSHIP: Managing God-Given Resources for God's Work

If you want to learn how to love the people in your life well, here is God's advice.

5. Answer without arguing. Proverbs 17:1 tells us "Better a dry crust with peace and quiet than a house full of feasting, with strife." This verse paints a very vivid picture of why we should pick our battles and watch our words.

6. *Share without pretending*. *Ephesians 4:15 reminds* us "Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of Him who is the head, that is, Christ." Don't lie to the ones you love to spare their feelings, be loving in sharing the truth.

7. **Promise without forgetting**. Proverbs 13:12 says "Hope deferred makes the heart sick, but a longing fulfilled is a tree of life." Don't make promises that you can't keep. This builds false trust and will bite you in the long run.

8. **Trust without wavering**. 1 Corinthians 13:6-7 reads "Love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, always perseveres."

9. *Enjoy without complaint*. *Philippians 2:14 tells us* "Do everything without grumbling or arguing..." This one is a tough one!

10. Forgive without punishing. Colossians 3:13 reminds us "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." Nobody is perfect, and we all slip up, so having compassion and understanding is key to showing love in the trying times.


