I have really enjoyed leading the Thursday night Bible study on Gideon. I love the daily study leading up to our meeting. And, the message by Priscilla Shirer is awesome! But, mostly, I look forward to the fellowship, the discussion, the sharing of ideas, and the prayer time. It is encouraging to know that I am not the only one struggling—yes, our struggles differ—but, we are ALL struggling with something. 


