



Thankfulness is at the heart of Christian living. Scripture repeatedly calls believers to cultivate gratitude—not only when life feels abundant, but also in seasons of challenge. Practicing Christian thankfulness is more than polite manners; it is a spiritual discipline that shapes the soul and strengthens faith and it requires practice.

1 Thessalonians 5:18 reminds us: "Give thanks in all circumstances; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Gratitude is not conditional on comfort—it flows from trust in God's sovereignty and goodness. Jesus Himself modeled thankfulness, offering thanks before meals, miracles, and even in moments of sorrow.

To become more thankful, we need to practice it daily. Small steps will sometimes bring the biggest results. Here are some of the steps I have taken to live a more purposeful life. You may find some of them helpful.

Begin and end the day by naming blessings, both big and small. It is amazing if you only take 2 minutes to name your blessings, how much impact it can have on you.

Meditate on passages that highlight God's provision and promises. Jim Collie gave me a 2025 daily devotion called "Walking in Grace" and I use that each morning. It takes me less than 5 minutes of reading, including the "Digging Deeper" feature.

Express thankfulness by serving others, embodying love in action. Anyone that knows me, knows that my "love language" is food. I love to cook for people and serve them a warm and cozy meal. This leads to me being more thankful for my food and having pretty much anything available to me.

Write down moments of grace each day to cultivate awareness of God's presence. This is something I struggle with....actually writing it down, but I have started to use my calendar feature on my phone to jot down specific things that have occurred that day that I want to remember later on.

Practicing thankfulness shifts my perspective. It teaches me, as a believer, to see beyond difficulties, recognizing God's hand at work. Gratitude nurtures humility, deepens joy, and strengthens community, as thankful hearts naturally encourage and uplift others.

Let's all try to be more thankful and to show that thankfulness at home and in our church. Be more open to God's nudging in our life.
