I love a good story. Stories entertain. Stories teach. Stories enrich. I hope the following story does all three.

John Maxwell tells the story of a father and his young son eating lunch at McDonalds. The father ordered their food. When they sat down to eat, he thought the french fries in front of his son were irresistible. He reached out to grab a few fries. 


