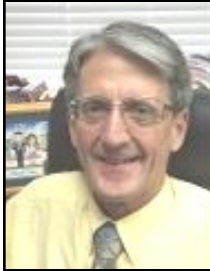

Dear Church Family and Friends,

We are continuing to explore nine personality types and illustrate each through a Bible character. So far, we have looked at the Apostle Paul, a Perfectionist and John, a Helper. Now, we will explore the Achiever, as seen in Jacob.

Achievers have a tremendous drive to succeed. The Bible captures this idea by showing Jacob competing with his brother, Esau, while they were still in the womb.

The name Jacob means "trickster". He tricked others to further his own ends, damaging his closest relationships. He manipulated Esau out of his birthright (inheritance and family leadership rights) and Esau's special blessing.

The damage finally caught up to Jacob. Esau wanted to kill him. At this low point of his life God told Jacob in a dream that He wanted to use him to bless all the people of the earth.

Later, Esau caught up to Jacob. Nightfall came and "Jacob was left alone and a man wrestled him until daybreak" (Gen. 32:24). Jacob had nowhere else to run. Then, a "man" representing God wrestled Jacob.

As they wrestled, Jacob's hip was put out of joint. It was then that God changed his name from Jacob to Israel. This represented the changing of Jacob's personality...from trickster to one in constant relationship with God.

The personality of this Achiever was redeemed. Instead of selfishly advancing his own ends, his personality was re-directed to advance the purpose of God to bless the whole earth.

Are you an Achiever? Do you know one? Claim the personality God gave you and make the most of it for His glory. Next week, we will look at the Romantic. Romantics feel deeply and live passionately. Their downside is to be self-focused.

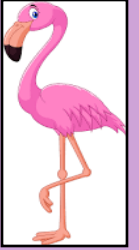


Scripture for the Week

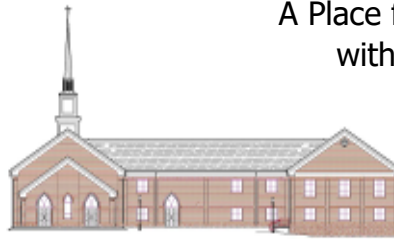
