Dear church family and friends,

It is said that Jesus asked 307 questions. But...Jesus only directly answered 3 questions! Puzzling, isn't it? Here is the One Who claims to be the Savior. Instead of telling people all the answers, He asks them for answers (to His questions).

Jesus' questions rock us back on our heels. They penetrate deeply. "Do you believe I can do this?" "Why are you afraid?" "What do you think of Christ?" "Do you love me?" "Why do you call me 'Lord' but do not obey?" "Why do you see the speck in your brother's eye?" "What good is it for a man to gain the whole world and lose his soul?"

If lesus gave a simple one sentence answer, the effect might not go beyond the surface. His questions call for reflection, prayer, study, self-evaluation, and a very careful look in the mirror.

Jesus' hearers are not given easy answers. His questions create space for the Holy Spirit to guide. There is opportunity to **discover** the answer. Then, the answer means something. Then, the answer takes on power to alter the course of our lives. Then, the learning process can be completed by putting these answers into practice.

Instead of a handing someone a simple answer, a better answer might be a good question. What questions has lesus put in your mind and heart with which you need to wrestle? What are good spiritual questions we can ask of others?






