Where would we be today if we never left our comfort zones? We would have been dying little by little each day, each week, each month, and each year. The growth comes when we step out of the comfort zone. All the while something inside says, "No, don't do it!"

We do not need God if we stay in the comfort zone. We can do everything without Him. But, when we step into the faith zone, uncharted waters and lands, we depend on God more. There is challenge. To be truly alive means to face challenge; otherwise, we shrivel up on the inside.

The early church had Jesus' Great Commission (given five times) to take the gospel to Jerusalem, Judea, Samaria, and the ends of the earth. When Paul came along, the church was still stuck in Jerusalem. They were stuck in their comfort zone. The pain of persecution scattered the church like seeds.

In what ways do we need to step out of the comfort zone into the faith zone? It means to do new things with new people. Think about it. Pray about it. God will bless you and others through you.




