



I have been thinking upon the fact that we are without our spiritual leader (pastor) and during these times, lots of things can happen. Churches can flounder without an active leader and things can occur that can divide a congregation into two or three separate entities. There are many causes of this and throughout our Christian history, from the earliest congregations to the present day. The churches began dividing during the Great Schism of 1054 to the Protestant Reformation of the 16th century, theological disagreements, cultural differences, and leadership disputes have repeatedly fractured the body of Christ.

There are many causes of this:

**Doctrinal Disputes** – Differing interpretations of Scripture often lead to opposing camps, each convinced of their theological

**Personal Conflicts** – Pride, ego, and unresolved interpersonal tensions can escalate into church-wide schisms.

**Spiritual Deception** – The Bible warns that false teachings and misleading revelations can draw believers away from truth, sowing discord.

Cultural and Political Pressures – External influences, from societal trends to political ideologies, can polarize congregations.

#### Consequences

Weakened Witness – Jesus prayed for unity so "that the world may believe" (John 17:21). Division undermines this testimony, giving skeptics reason to doubt the faith.

Loss of Fellowship – Members may leave, relationships fracture, and the sense of spiritual family erodes.

**Distraction from Mission** – Energy spent on internal disputes detracts from evangelism, discipleship, and service.

#### The Call to Unity

Scripture repeatedly urges believers to "make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace" (Ephesians 4:3). This unity does not mean uniformity, but a shared commitment to Christ above personal preference. Church leaders and members alike are called to humility, forgiveness, and a focus on the gospel's core truths.

In a world already divided, the church's unity can be a powerful witness—showing that love, grace, and truth can hold diverse people together under the one Lord, Christ Jesus.

Let's get involved, stay involved and pray for our leadership (deacons, leadership team, etc.) to guide our church and to find us the right shepherd to lead us on into the future.
