Below is a compelling, true story told by a pastor friend of mine, Dan Stanley. Read it carefully. It is a modern- day parable.

"One beautiful spring evening, I attended a Clarke County High School baseball game. At about the third inning, I decided to walk to the

concession stand. Clarke County was losing.

I heard a voice that caught my attention. A man was red in the face, screaming obscenities at the home plate umpire. His son was pitching for Clarke County.

A man approached him from the visitors' bleachers. He walked up to the angry father and said, 'Is that your son pitching? I just want to let you know that he is pitching a good game. I know you are proud.' As he walked away, he said, 'By the way, my son is pitching for the other team.' Instantly, the angry father became composed, relaxed, at ease, like a completely different person."

This story has a message for us all. First, I have a question. What changed the angry father? Watch the scene in your mind: the words, tones, and body language.

The other father saw something few, if anyone else, saw. This allowed him to approach the irate man differently. He became a peace-maker. Jesus said in Matthew 5:9, "Blessed are the peacemakers, for they will be called sons of God."

Our world, near and far, needs peacemakers. I pray that I can be more like the peacemaker in the story above. Even more, I pray that I can be more like the Prince of Peace.


