


With Covid, it's been awhile since we have had folks over, & we would love to be able to just visit & fellowship together on Sunday evenings from 6-7pm!

Come & celebrate the Feast of Tabernacles with us at Wise Baptist on Friday, September 29!

This year, we are celebrating 3 of the most important Jewish feasts that Jesus faithfully participated in while on earth. You may remember that in May, we celebrated the Feast of Weeks with a meal of traditional Jewish dishes, music & even dancing!

Can Christians celebrate the Jewish Feasts?
