Dear church family & friends,

How we make decisions affects every relationship. This affects friendships, marriages, brothers and schools. churches. bosses/employees, sisters. fellow employees, communities, and nations.

As the early church grew, relationships became more complicated. Once, there were only twelve disciples. Even that small a group did not always make the best decisions. The early church grew explosively, however, a big issue threatened to derail the Christian movement when it was at its highest point.

lewish Christians outside of Palestine complained that their widows were being neglected in the daily food distributions. These widows depended on this daily distribution of food to survive. lt was delivered to their homes. Suppose there were two hundred fifty widows were affected. If each told ten people, that would mean twenty-five hundred people heard about it! That could create great division.

The solution was for the twelve apostles to get clear about God's calling. Two hundred and fifty widows divided by twelve disciples would be over twenty widows each, who required daily food delivery. Suppose they also had to travel on foot to each home. That would take up all of their time.

Ministry to the widows was important. How could the apostles keep focused on their calling, "ministry of the Word" (teaching and preaching) and still meet this need? Others needed to be involved. Seven deacons were called upon. Their faithful ministry calmed the turmoil and the church grew.

The application...? Get clear about what God wants you to do. The talents, interests, and abilities that God has given you will help sort that out. Then, a miracle happens! When all of God's people are doing what He calls them to do, we are blessed, others are blessed, and the Kingdom of God advances!


