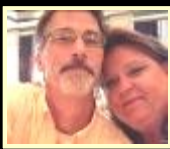
⇒ Arrive about 5:30pm to assist with setting

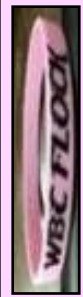

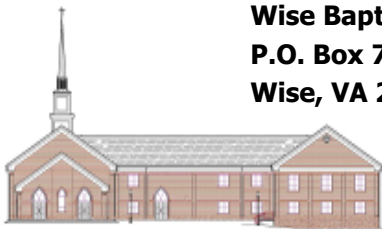

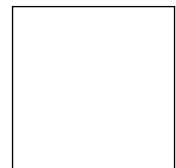
