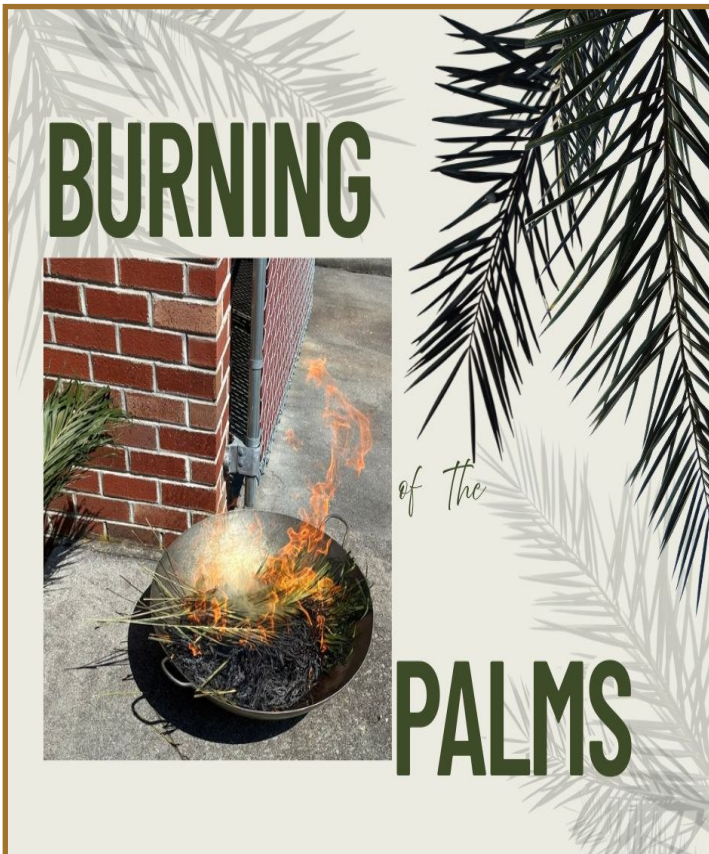
Giving is an Act of Worship

Let's all put forth a bit of effort to help grow us as a church and to help us grow our church.

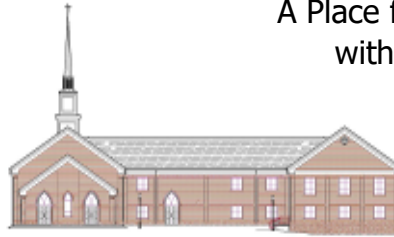
