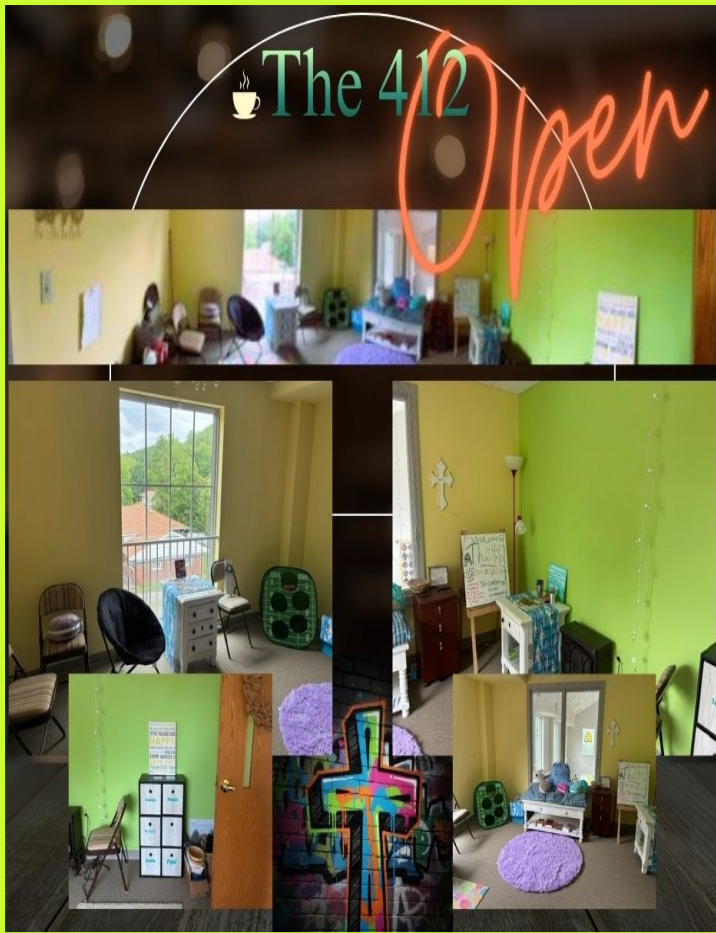

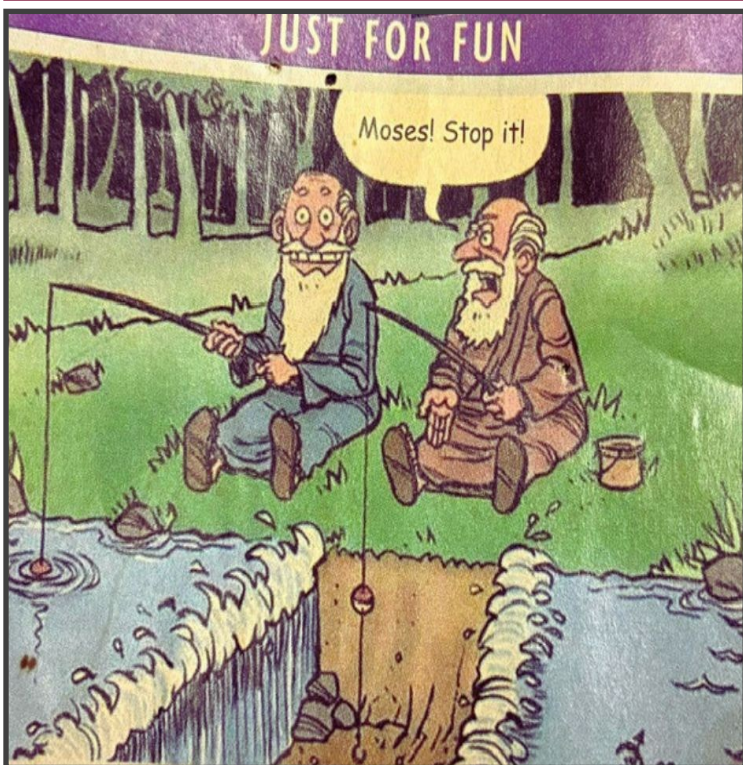

For Christians, Jesus is not just a historical figure or a distant Savior—He is the living center of faith and life. The Bible teaches that without Him, we can do nothing (John 15:5). His sacrifice on the cross brings forgiveness of sins, reconciling us to God. But our need for Him doesn't end at salvation.

We need Jesus for guidance when life's path is unclear, for strength when trials weigh us down, and for peace when the world feels chaotic. His presence transforms fear into courage and despair into hope. In Him, we find not only eternal life but also the daily grace to live faithfully.

To be a Christian is to walk with Jesus—not just to know about Him, but to depend on Him in every moment.

Christianity is built entirely upon the person and work of Jesus Christ. Without Him, there is no gospel, no salvation, and no hope of eternal life. Scripture affirms that "there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

Christ's death satisfies God's justice, and His resurrection secures victory over sin and death. Beyond salvation, Jesus is the believer's source of truth, moral direction, and spiritual power. The Holy Spirit—sent by Christ—guides, convicts, and empowers Christians to live in obedience.

In short, Christians need Jesus not only to begin their spiritual journey but to sustain it. He is the foundation, the sustainer, and the goal of the Christian life.

As a Christian, I've learned that my faith is not about rules or rituals—it's about a relationship with Jesus. Without Him, I'm left to face life's struggles in my own strength, and that strength runs out quickly.

When I'm overwhelmed, He gives me peace. When I fail, He offers forgiveness. When I'm uncertain, His Word lights my path. I need Him not just for the promise of heaven, but for the grace to live today.

Jesus is more than my Savior—He is my friend, my guide, and my hope. Without Him, I am lost; with Him, I am found.

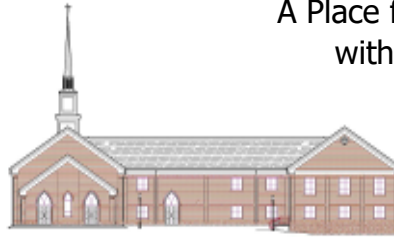
